



Trademarks Registry – The NAPIM Member’s resources website at <https://NAPIMTech.org> now provides a searchable trademark listing page (<https://napimtech.org/Trademarks>). Company trademark lists can also be downloaded from this page.

The trademark registry is a publicly available resource which lists trademarks from both NAPIM members and non-members – from both ink manufacturers and suppliers to the ink manufacturing industries. NAPIM will list all legitimate trademarks including those currently registered with the U.S. Patents and Trademarks Office (USPTO). NAPIM is working with Ink World magazine to publish these trademarks on an annual basis.

Interested parties can list (or update an existing listing) by contacting NAPIM (napim@napim.org) and providing the required commercialization documentation. Appropriate documentation includes:

USPTO Registered Trademarks:

- the mark itself
- the name and address of the registrant
- the number of the registration
- the date of registration
- the goods mentioned in the registration upon which the mark is used
- the trademark Act under which the mark is registered
- whether the mark has become incontestable
- if the registration is more than 20 years old, indicate whether the registration has been renewed

Unregistered Trademarks:

- the mark itself
- the name, address and company affiliation of the registrant
- the date of first use
- proof of commercialization within six months preceding the request. Suitable documents (min. 1) include:
 - Dated invoice without price information
 - Dated product promotional/marketing information
 - Dated technical data sheet
 - Dated safety data sheet
